01	The Dish antennas (1.2mts) of MANA TV ROTs located in the government institutions, offices, schools and colleges in the state of Andhra Pradesh have to be re oriented as per the NSS-12 Satellite parameters and specifications given by SAPNET from the existing orientation on INSAT-3B satellite 83 degrees East. The dish antenna has to be aligned with the new satellite NSS-12 in Azimuth and elevation and the satellite receiver (set top box) to be reconfigured for the new downlink frequency for the maximum RF signal strength so that clear and clean video and audio is available on the picture monitor to the customer satisfaction at the Sites. All the newly received parameters of the down link frequency, its signal strengths, video, audio quality to be recorded and a certificate to that effect for the satisfactory performance to be obtained from the caretaker/custodian of the site and to be submitted to SAPNET for verification and processing of the bill payment. After reorientation of the dish antenna, it has to be secured in the correct position and tighten without getting distributed due to winds etc. If any AMC contract technician for the ROT is available at the site he also may be appraised of the change and obtain his signature in the custodian certificate for having done the work satisfactorily. After retuning and orientation the customer has to be appraised and given details of the new downlink frequency parameters for their records. 1.DEFINITIONS

General conditions of proposed contract (GCC)

Definitions

In this contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated. Terms defined in general instructions to bidders section shall have the same meaning.

- a) **“Contract”** means the agreement entered into between the SAPNET and the bidder, as recorded in the contract form, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein;
- b) **“Contract price”** means the price payable to the vendor under the contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations;
- c) **“Incidental services”** means those services ancillary to services, such as transportation and insurance, and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training and other such obligations of the vendor covered under the contract;
- d) **“GCC”** means the general conditions of contract contained in this section.
- e) **“SCC”** means the special conditions of contract if any.
- f) **“SAPNET”** means Society for Andhra Pradesh Network.
- g) **“ User”** means ultimate recipient of goods and services
- h) **“ Bidder”** means the individual or firm supplying the goods and services under this contract.
- i) **“Project site”**, where applicable, means the place(s) where goods/services are to be made available to user. Pls refer site list
- j) **“Day”** means calendar day.
- k) **EMD** means “Earnest Money Deposit” for the Bid security value
BID Security means value of money Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to be deposited with CEO, SAPNET A/C as bid security. It shall be in the form of Demand draft in favor of CEO, SAPNET payable at Hyderabad in scheduled Bank. (Refundable)
- l) **Performance Security** means after awarding of contract to the agency, they must give bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of contract value or Demand Draft shall be deposited in CEO, SAPNET A/c.
- m) **CEO** means Chief Executive Officer
- n) **ESE** means Earth Station engineer

2. SOURCE OF FUNDS – SAPNET funds

3. ELIGIBLE BIDDERS

3.1 This Invitation for Bids is open to all bidders who are in the TV broadcast field & cable operations & Satellite equipment

3.2 All bidders shall provide Forms of Bid and Qualification Information.

4. QUALIFICATION OF THE BIDDER

Technically qualified to operate the satellite dish antennas, cable & TV systems with minimum experience of 3 years in the respective field & Sound experience in electrical and electronic equipment

(b) Technical Experience:

- To qualify for award of the contract, each bidder should submit detailed technical experience to handle this type of work. Three years of experience in the respective field (as mentioned above)

5. COST OF BIDDING

5.1 The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his Bid, and the SAPNET will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.

6. CLARIFICATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

6.1 A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding documents may notify to the SAPNET in writing at the SAPNET's address indicated in the invitation to bid. SAPNET will respond to any request for clarification, which is received earlier than (05) five days prior to the deadline for submission of bids.

7. AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

1. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, SAPNET, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder may modify the bidding documents by issue of an amendment.
2. All prospective bidders will be notified of the amendment and such modification will be binding on all bidders
3. In order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing the bids, the SAPNET at its discretion may extend the dead line for the submission of bids.

8. LANGUAGE OF THE BID

All documents relating to the bid shall be in the English language

9. DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BID

The bid submitted by the bidder shall comprise the Price bid, bid Security and cost of Tender in a sealed cover super-scribing Bid No. Bid security details, validity etc.

10. BID PRICES

10.1 The unit wise (ROT) estimate (based on ROT list) may be quoted

10.2 All duties, taxes, and other levies payable by the contractor under the contract, or for any other cause and included in the price. The bidder shall verify the correctness and quote his price.

10.3. The rates and prices quoted by the bidder shall be firm throughout the contract period.

11. CURRENCIES OF BID AND PAYMENT in Indian Rupees. (INR)

12. BID VALIDITY

12.1 Bids shall remain valid till 90days after the last date for submission of bids. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the SAPNET as non-responsive.

12.2 In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original time limit, SAPNET may request the bidders to extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. The request and the bidder's responses shall be made in writing. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting his bid security. A bidder agreeing to the request will not be required or permitted to modify his bid, but will be required to extend the validity of his bid security for a period of the extension.

13. BID SECURITY (EMD)

13.1 The Bidder shall furnish, as part of his Bid, a Bid security of **Rs.5, 000/-** (Rupees Five Thousand Only). This bid security shall be in the form of Demand Draft in favor of CEO, SAPNET payable at Hyderabad in scheduled Bank.

13.2 Any bid not accompanied by Bid Security shall be rejected by the SAPNET as non-responsive.

- 13.3 The Bid Security of the unsuccessful bidder will be returned within 28 days of the end of the bid validity period specified
- 13.4 The Bid Security of the successful bidder will be discharged when the bidder has furnished the required performance Security and fulfill all other formalities relating to this contract after taking necessary certificate from Earth Station Engineer.
- 13.5 The Bid Security may be forfeited
- a) if the Bidder withdraws the Bid after Bid opening during the period of Bid validity:
 - b) if the Bidder does not accept the correction of the Bid Price,
 - c) in the case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails within the specified time limit to
 - (i) Sign the Agreement or
 - (ii) Furnish the required performance Security.

14. ALTERNATIVE PROPOSALS BY BIDDERS

Bidders shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the bidding documents. Alternatives proposals by bidders will not be considered.

15. FORMAT AND SIGNING OF BID

- 15.1. The Bidder shall prepare one original and one copy of the documents comprising the bid super scribing "ORIGINAL" and "COPY". In the event of discrepancy between them, the original shall prevail.
- 15.2. The original and copy of the Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder. All pages of the bid where entries or amendments have been made shall be initialled by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 15.3. The Bid shall contain no alterations or additions, except those to comply with the instructions, issued by the SAPNET, or as necessary to correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the bid and all officers present and other company representatives also.
- 15.4. The Bidder shall furnish information as described in the form of Bid on commissions or gratuities, if any, paid or to be paid to agents relating to this Bid, and to contract execution if the Bidder is awarded the contract.

16. LATE BIDS

- 16.1. Any Bid received by the SAPNET after the deadline will be rejected & returned unopened to the bidder.

17. MODIFICATION & WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

- No bid can be modified subsequent to the deadline for submission of bids
- No bid can be withdrawn after the submission of Bids. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval will result in the forfeiture of its bid security value of Rs.5,000/- (EMD).

18. BID OPENING

The SAPNET will open all the Bids received (except those received late), in the presence of the Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend at the time on the date and the place specified. In the event of the specified date of Bid opening being declared a holiday for the Employer, the Bids will be opened at the appointed time and location on the next working day.

19. PROCESS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation, and comparison of Bids and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Bidder has been announced. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the SAPNET's processing of Bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of his Bid.

20. EXAMINATION OF BIDS AND DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS

20.1. Prior to the detailed evaluation of Bids, the SAPNET will determine whether each Bid (a) meets the **eligibility criteria defined** (b) has been properly signed; (c) is accompanied by the required securities and ; (d) is substantially responsive to the requirements of the Bidding documents.

20.2. A substantially responsive Bid is one which conforms to all the terms, conditions, and specifications of the Bidding documents, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one (a) which affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the Work; (b) which limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the Bidding documents, the SAPNET's rights or the Bidder's obligations under the Contract, or (c) whose rectification would affects unfairly the competitive position of other Bidders presenting substantially responsive Bids.

21. CORRECTION OF ERRORS

- a). Correction of errors will be rectified by amending the Tender call notice after verifying the original document (Tender Call Document), if any mistakes are observed by the SAPNET officials after releasing of newspaper advertisement to the press.
- b). After publishing tender call advertisement in the newspapers and uploading tender call in the SAPNET website, if any typography mistakes or any other data related to it is noticed by the bidders/SAPNET/IT&C/other parties and are brought to the notice of the CEO, SAPNET, will consider for valid corrections by amending tender call

advertisement as per the norms of SAPNET.

- c). If SAPNET wants to add any additional information related to the tender call or data deletion is required in the tender call, SAPNET will issue amendment to the tender call before closing date/dead line.

22. EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF BIDS

22.1 The SAPNET will evaluate and compare only the Bids determined to be substantially responsive.

22.2 In evaluating the Bids, the SAPNET will determine for each Bid the evaluated Bid Price.

23. AWARD CRITERIA

SAPNET will award the Contract to the Bidder whose Bid has been determined and who has offered the lowest evaluated Bid Price.

24. SAPNET'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS WITHOUT ASSIGNING ANY REASONS

Notwithstanding to any clause, the SAPNET reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to cancel the Bidding process and reject all Bids, at any time prior to the award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the SAPNET's action.

25. NOTIFICATION OF AWARD AND SIGNING OF AGREEMENT

25.1 The Bidder whose Bid has been accepted will be notified of the award by the SAPNET prior to expiration of the Bid period by registered letter. This letter (hereinafter in the Conditions of Contract called the "Letter of Acceptance") will state the sum that the SAPNET will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution, completion, and certification of the works by the contractor in all respects as prescribed by the Contract (hereinafter and in the Contract called the "Contract Price").

25.2 The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract, subject to the furnishing of a performance security.

25.3 Upon furnishing by the successful Bidder of the performance Security, the SAPNET will notify the other Bidders that their Bids have been unsuccessful and return the bid security to them.

26. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

26.1 Within 15 days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the Successful Bidder shall deliver to the SAPNET a Performance Security in any of the forms given below for an amount equivalent to **10% of the Contract price** A bank guarantee valid for six months from the

date of issue in the form given or Bank draft, in favour of CEO, SAPNET payable at Hyderabad drawn on any scheduled Bank.

26.2 If the performance security is provided by the successful Bidder in the form of a Bank Guarantee, it shall be issued by a Nationalized Bank and acceptable to the SAPNET.

26.3 Failure of the successful Bidder to comply with the requirements shall constitute sufficient grounds for cancellation of the award and forfeiture of the Bids Security (EMD)

27. TERMS OF PAYMENT

As consideration for implementing the work, SAPNET will release full (100%) payment within a months time on submission of valid bills submitted after completion of execution and Acceptance Test (AT) duly supported by certificate from the custodian.

28. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES.

29.1 The Bidders/ Contractors observe the highest standard of ethics during the execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, SAPNET:

(a) Defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

- i. "Corrupt Practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution, and
- ii. "Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a bidding process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Borrower, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Borrower of the benefits of free and open competition.

(b) Will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

(c) Will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a Bank financed contract if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing a Bank-financed contract.

30. QUALITY ASSURANCE PLAN

Standards

- The bidder shall conform to the standards mentioned in the specifications, and, when no applicable standard is mentioned, the authoritative standards appropriate to the PRASARA BHARATHI Television broadcasting' shall apply. Such standard shall be the latest issued by the concerned institution.

- The services provided under this contract shall conform to television broadcast standards in the respective fields.

31. FORCE MAJEURE:

1. The bidder shall not be liable for forfeiture of its implementation Guarantee, Performance guarantee, levy of liquidated damages for default if and to the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Agreement is the result of Force Majeure.
2. For Purpose of this clause “Force Majeure” means an unforeseeable event beyond the control of the bidder and not involving the bidder’s fault of negligence. Such events shall include, but are not restricted to, acts of the SAPNET in its sovereign capacity, Acts of God, war or revolution, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, policy decisions of foreign countries regarding import by India and freight/import embargoes.
3. If a Force Majeure situation arises, the bidder shall promptly notify SAPNET in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the SAPNET in writing, the bidder shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as is reasonable practical and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance.

32. APPLICABLE LAW:

The agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with appropriate Indian laws and any amendments to it.

33. TAXES & DUTIES

The bidder shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fee etc

34. TRANSPORTATION:

The bidder shall make his own transport arrangements to travel to the site on his own cost.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

SOCIETY FOR ANDHRA PRADESH NETWORK (SAPNET)

S E C T I O N – I I I

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:

(1) GUARANTEE:

The contractor shall be responsible for the satisfactory performance of ROT & reconfiguration of ROT with the new satellite NSS-12. Any complaint received from the custodian, before payment of the respective ROT bills is to be attended by the bidder and rectify the system at his own cost.

(2) RATE:

The tenders have to quote the rate per ROT. The rate quoted is FIRM and inclusive of all taxes, and all other expenses involved in this regard. Total contract price for the no.of ROTs also to be quoted.

(3) CONTRACT PERIOD:

The period of contract is two weeks June/July 2010 (15 working days which may be extendable depending on need of the custodians or on genuine grounds)) The award of contract extension is solely at the discretion of SAPNET.

(5) ACCIDENTS:

SAPNET will not be responsible for any damages or compensation payable in consequence of any accident or injuries to any of the Contractor's personnel or any third party.

(6) INSURANCE:

6.1 **INDEMNITIES:** The contractor is liable for and indemnifies the SAPNET against losses, expenses and claims for loss or damage to physical property, personal injury and death caused by his own acts or omissions.

6.2 The contractor indemnifies the SAPNET against claims to damages caused by the movement of his equipment or workmen.

6.3 The contractor shall submit an "Indemnity Bond" to the SAPNET incorporating the above points before taking up the execution of the work.

(7) TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENT:

The Contractor shall make the transport arrangement at bidders cost for his material, and workers while carrying out the work & during transit

(8) EVALUATION AND COMPARISION OF BID:

The SAPNET will evaluate and compare the bids, which have been determined to be substantially responsive.
